<p>1.</p>	<p>Travel and Transport (Minister for Health and Safety): Traffic and parking outside the schools is dangerous and we need to do more to encourage more people to walk and park safely. It has been raised by children and parents that this is becoming more of an issue, particularly at the Junior School.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Minister and Y1/Y2 class reps to carry out a traffic survey at the Junior and Infant School sites. - Pupil and staff travel survey to be carried out across both schools. - Parking signs to be designed and shared outside schools – and with parents. - Letter to MP to share our concerns and ask for solutions. - Parent letter / parking agreement. - Walk to School Award. 	
<p>2.</p>	<p>Team Points (Ministers for Behaviour and Wellbeing) Children from winning house teams have not yet had their rewards.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Ministers to create a list of possible rewards for the team to select from and to have it signed off by Mr Reed. - Re-introduce the ‘Most Improved’ Award for the Infant and Junior Schools – Ministers to lead – speak to Miss Hawes or Miss Roberts about certificates. 	

3.	<p>Playtimes (Ministers for Sports)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Shelters for Y6 wellies needs to be complete – speak to Mr Meads - Need more bike storage – ER shared that this is in progress on the BJS playground. - Ministers to arrange a walk around with Mr Hearn – identify what is needed and the consistency of rules in each areas, e.g. is football allowed on the playground? - Assemblies from Pupil Parliament and Mr Hearn at KS1 and KS2 – Ministers to find out the dates for the next one. 	
4.	<p>Toilets (Minister for Health and Safety / Ministers for Behaviour and Wellbeing)</p> <p>Not well cared for. Toilet in KS1 has been fixed recently which has made things better.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Y4 toilets – there is only 1 toilet and 1 urinal. - Y6 toilets – children eating in them and they are messy. More sanitary bins to be provided. - Ministers to make and laminate posters and talk to the children in assembly. - Ministers to speak to Mr Meads about additional bins etc. and provision of sanitary products? 	
5.	<p>Cooking Lessons (Minister for Education)</p> <p>Year 2 Class reps brought attention to the lack of cookery classes in their school and would like more.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Minister for Education to speak to Mrs Giffen about timetable for cooking to ensure the Infant School is included.
