Dear parents/carers of pupils in Year 5,

Last year, parents/carers asked via our parent reps, if at the beginning of the academic year we could send out approximate costings for trips and experiences for the whole school year. This is to allow parents/carers to budget or save for these things. We agree this is a good idea as we want as many children as possible to go on these trips.

There was also a lot of discussion last year around the fact paying for your child to go on a trip is a voluntary contribution. However, if we don't have enough contributions, we cannot afford to subsidise all of the trips we offer here at Broughton. If you cannot afford to pay for a trip, either in part or in full, please speak to a member of our admin team. This will always be dealt with sensitively and confidentially.

Generating costings for proposed trips and experiences has not been an easy task because prices do not stay the same each year; we also have to factor in travel costs. The prices below are therefore approximate and we cannot guarantee that they are the exact amounts you will be asked to pay. However, hopefully they give you a good indication.
