Re: Secondary Transfer Test

Dear families,

As you will be aware, the current Year 5 cohort are due to take the Secondary Transfer Tests (or '11 plus tests') in September 2024. The dates have now been confirmed by the local authority as 10th to 12th September for all children attending Buckinghamshire primary schools. If you wish for your child to take the test, they are automatically registered, so you do not need to do anything. Familiarisation booklets will be sent to your child's home address on 4th July. However, **if you do not** want your child to sit the test, you will need to let Mr Reed know by **Wednesday 25th June** at the latest, in writing.
