We are now in a position to be able to offer extra-curricular activity clubs for the Spring term. **All Clubs will start week commencing 3<sup>rd</sup> February and will finish during the week commencing 17<sup>th</sup> March 2025.**

We will be using School Cloud’s Club booking software, which enables you to select the club your child would like to take part in once logged in. Please use the following links to log into School Cloud:

The following information will be required:

- Student’s name and surname
- Parent’s first name and surname
- Parent’s email address (this must be the e mail address the school holds as a contact detail)
- Student’s date of birth

**Bookings will open on Friday 24<sup>th</sup> January at 6.00pm for Broughton Infant School and 6.30pm for Broughton Junior School and will close at 9am on Friday 31<sup>st</sup> January 2025.**

The system is run on a first come – first served basis and we are limiting the number of clubs to 1 per child to begin with. If we have more spaces available at the closing date, bookings will open up again for you to book a second club for your child.

**IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING CHOIR CLUB: If your child currently attends the choir club and they wish to continue, you will need to re-apply for your child’s space in the usual way, using the booking info above.**

Following your booking, a confirmation email will be sent to you detailing your child's place. Please ensure that your email contact that the school holds for you is up to date. The maximum number of places for each activity is limited and once spaces in each club have been filled, the system will not allow you to make a booking.

Regrettably, children whose needs during school-time demand specific additional support, may not be able to be included if such levels of appropriate support are not available during these 'out-of-school' times. **Please ensure your child is picked up on time. Please note that late collection on more than 3 occasions, may result in your child being removed from their club.**

In the interests of the safety and well-being of all children, it is vital that the School office is contacted by phone before the start time of the activity if your child is unable to attend. Similarly, if arrangements for the collection of your child change, it is vital that the School is informed of these.

The School's responsibility to ensure the safety of all children when leaving the premises also means that we must have written permission for any Year 6 child to walk home alone.
