Visit to Aylesbury Town Library

Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of our continued commitment to improve access to high-quality literature, we have organised another visit to Aylesbury Town Library for **all** our children.

The trip itself will take place during the normal school day and children should be dropped off and collected at the normal school times. The visits will take place, regardless of the weather, so please do check in advance and ensure that your child comes with the appropriate clothing for rain/sun. Years 1-6 if this happens on a day that your child does PE then they can continue to come to school in their PE Kit.

All children from Early Years to Year 6 will walk down to the Library (using the same route as we always take to the theatre and library) and will have a session led by one of the Librarians. The date for each class is specified below:

EYFS	Between 9.30 and 12.00	Wednesday 24th September
Year 1	Between 9.30 and 12.00	Monday 6th October
Year 2	Between 9.30 and 12.00	Monday 13th October
Year 3	Between 9.30 and 12.00	Wednesday 8th October
Year 4	Between 9.30 and 12.00	Wednesday 17th September
Year 5	Between 9.30 and 12.00	Monday 22nd September
Year 6	Between 9.30 and 12.00	Monday 15th September

If your child is already a member of the library, then they can bring their library card with them – but please remember that any books they check out will need to be carried back to school.
